

This class is designed to give students an opportunity for additional guided practice, to help reinforce the targets from your Algebra I class. All students in this class are expected to be prepared to work on math the whole period every day. Bring your book, assignments, pencil, calculator, notebook, good attitude, and good work ethic EVERY DAY. This class is not an individual study hall time for homework, as students will receive a letter grade and elective credit for this class.

**GRADING PROCEDURE (Traditional Academic Percentage Grades):**

**ACADEMIC WORK (50%)**

- Every student every class period will receive 5 pts for his/her academic work
- This will be scored on how each student participates in all class activities that day
- Students are expected to be engaged at all times during the R-T-E (see below) portion of class
- Students will NOT be working on assignments during this portion of the class

**PERSONAL MANAGEMENT (25%)**

- Every student every class period will receive 5 pts for his/her personal management
- This includes being on time and having proper materials in class

**REGULAR COURSE GRADE (25%)**

- Every student will have their Regular Course Grade entered into their Lab Class Gradebook at the end of every 6-Week grading period.

- THIS CLASS DOES NOT REPLACE DOING THE REGULAR CLASS ASSIGNMENTS.
- STUDENTS IN LAB CLASS ARE EXPECTED TO BE DOING THEIR ASSIGNMENTS IN THEIR REGULAR CLASS.
- STUDENTS MAY BE REMOVED FROM LAB CLASS IF THEY ARE NOT DOING THEIR REGULAR CLASS ASSIGNMENTS.

**CLASS FORMAT (based on regular 48 minute class period):**

**Part 1: REVIEW – TEACH – EXTEND:** 40 minutes

- A REVIEW of past material
- A lesson to TEACH the day's material
- A lesson to EXTEND into the next few days material

**Part 2: Guided Homework:** 8 minutes

- Students work on their homework for that day from the regular course.

**Needed Supplies:**

- \*2 White board or dry erase markers

- \*scientific calculator (TI-30X IIS preferred)
- \*pencils, ruler
