Materials: 9th Exploring Life Beyond HS Part 2 Handout (In box, 1 per group)

Procedure:

1. Begin advisory according to personal preference.
2. Take attendance.
3. Read Announcements.
4. Divide your students into groups (average of 3-4 per group). This is a great chance to mix up students and have them work with different people than they normally would. Assign each group one of the following post-high options.
 1. 4 year college/university
 2. Community college
 3. Trade School
 4. Apprenticeship program
 5. Military
 6. Workforce
5. Hand out to each group their assigned questions. Students should discuss & research their assigned post-high option and answer the questions below for their post-high option. Allow students to use a computer or their cell phones to research the answers if no one in the group knows the answer.
6. Resources: Google, University & College webpages, Government Military webpages, Edutopia.org, Silverton High School website.
7. Give students 10 minutes to answer their 2 questions. If they are not done, stop them and have them present what they did find. Use the whole class as a resource for unanswered questions. Many students have parents who work in a variety of careers.
8. End advisory according to personal preference.

4 year college/ university

- List 3 examples of 4 year colleges/universities in Oregon. (Ideas: Portland State University, George Fox University, Southern Oregon University)
- Research 3 careers that require a 4 year degree. Share the average salary for 1 of these careers? (Ideas: Electrical Engineer, Teacher, Officer in the military, etc.)

Community College

- List 3 examples of community colleges in Oregon. (Ideas: Chemeketa, Clackamas, Linn Benton)
- Research 3 careers that require a 2 year degree. Share the average salary of 1 of the careers. (Ideas: Dental Hygienist, Emergency Medical Technician, Early Childhood Education Teacher, paralegal, Civil Engineering technicians)

Trade School

- List 2 examples of trade schools (vocational Schools) in Oregon or the Pacific Northwest Region. (Art Institute of Portland, Oregon Culinary Institute, Pioneer Pacific College, etc.)
- What 3 types of careers can you go into with trade school education? What is the average salary of 1 of these careers? (Ideas: Graphic & Web Designer, Massage Therapy, Medical Insurance Billing, Chef, Hospitality Management)

Apprenticeship Programs

- What is an apprenticeship training program? (Ideas: Paid, on the job training in a highly skilled career)
- List 3 types of careers you can enter into through an apprenticeship. Share information about the average salaries of 1 of these careers. (Plumber, Carpenter, Telecommunications Installer)

Military

- List 3 types of careers you can go into in the military? (Ideas: Human Resources, Cryptologic Linguist, Photojournalist, Aircraft Mechanic)
- How much does an E-5 (enlisted, no college needed) with 6 years of service make in the military per month? How much does an O-3 (Officer, college required) with 6 years of service make in the military per month? (search military pay chart)

Straight to Workforce

- List 2 examples of jobs in Oregon that require a High School Diploma. (Sales Clerk, Barista, Office Assistant, Lube Technician)
- What is the average salary of 1 of these careers?
