

## EXTENDED APPLICATION PRESENTATION SCORING GUIDE

### Presentation (must include each aspect to meet standard – check when met)

- Introduce** your project
- Explain** the process used/timeline/work plan and journal highlights
- Explain** how, after completing your project, you are more prepared for the future
- Share** any new ideas you had during or after your project
- Explain** the next steps for your senior year
- Explain** the next steps for immediate post high-school plans
- Include** a visual aid (poster, PowerPoint, scrapbook, demonstration, etc.)

### Presentation Scoring Guide

**5 = Exceeds Standard   4 = Meets Standard   3 = Below Standard**

#### Relevance

- Student demonstrates a connection between the project and his or her post-high school goals and plans
- Student shows evidence of new learning, ideas, results, or conclusions appropriate to his or her personal, academic, and/or career interests and post-high school goals.

#### Rigor

- Student shows how he or she applied academic and specialized knowledge and skills appropriate to his or her personal, academic, and/or career interests and post-high school goals and plans.
- Student shows how he or she applied those skills in complex or non-routine situations where there was some individual responsibility and autonomy.

#### Reflection

- Student shows evidence of reflecting on the project's connection to his or her post-high school goals and plans.
- Student shows evidence of new learning, ideas, or conclusions as a result of participating in the project.
- Student shows evidence of reflecting on how he or she applied appropriate academic and specialized knowledge and skills in complex or non-routine situations during the project.
