Materials: Ballots (Placed in Box)

Procedure:

1. Begin advisory according to personal preference.
2. Take attendance.
3. Read announcements.
4. Collect AG Syllabi, Student Handbook (Back page of Handbook), and Guidelines for Student Conduct (Inside page) signed documents from students (Due today).
5. Distribute Homecoming Court Ballots
6. Explain the Homecoming ballots (Grades 9-11 will have 1 prince and 1 princess per grade. Grade 12 will have 4 princes and 4 princesses that will be eligible for Homecoming King and Queen).
7. Have students...
 - a. Vote for 1 boy and 1 girl.
 - b. The students with the most votes will represent their perspective class as HC Prince and Princess. Again only ballots with a single vote for a boy and a single vote for a girl will be counted.
8. Collect all ballots and place them in the envelope. An ASB student will be around to pick them up and deliver them to the office to be counted. If your classroom is missed, send an AG student to the main office to deliver the ballots.
9. Use the remaining time as a study hall day.
10. End advisory according to personal preference.
