

Freshmen, Sophomores, Juniors and Seniors

Procedure:

1. Begin advisory according to personal preference. Please feel free to take the time to catch up with your students, share pictures from the summer, or do an activity to reconnect with (or introduce) one another!
2. Take attendance.
3. Read announcements.
4. Share with students the AG schedule below so they know what to expect for the year. Please note: RIE days will not start until week 3 of the school year.
 - Monday:** Grade review with students/check-in/relationship building activities
 - Tuesday:** Lesson day
 - Wednesday:** Request day
 - Thursday:** Request day
 - Friday:** Assemblies/AG Study Hall day/Parties
5. Distribute Homecoming Court Ballots
6. Explain the Homecoming ballots (Grades 9-11 will have 1 prince and 1 princess per grade. Grade 12 will have 4 princes and 4 princesses that will be eligible for Homecoming King and Queen).
7. Have students...
 - a. Vote for 1 boy and 1 girl.
 - b. The students with the most votes will represent their perspective class as HC Prince and Princess. Again only ballots with a single vote for a boy and a single vote for a girl will be counted.
8. Collect all ballots and place them in the envelope. An ASB student will be around to pick them up and delivery them to the office to be counted.
9. End advisory according to personal preference.
