Mock Interview Info:

What: Mock Interviews for ALL juniors.

When: April 25th (scheduled times throughout the day)

Who: Juniors will be interviewed by staff and community volunteers

Where: Main Gym

- 1. Inform the class that they will all be participating in mock interviews on Tuesday, April 25th. All students will need to have copies of their cover letter, resume, and job application to bring to their mock interview. Interviews will last around 10 minutes each. Every student will be scheduled for an interview time on the 25th. Over the next three weeks, we will be doing activities to prepare for the mock interviews.
- 2. Complete the "Jigsaw Activity" using the Careers 2016 magazine articles listed below.
- 3. Step 1: Form 5 small groups of equal size.
 - Group 1: Read *Prepare for a Winning Job Search* and *Get it from the Source* p. 16-17.
 - Group 2: Read Spelling Mistakes, Poor Grammar Hurt Job Search, How to tell is a Job is a Scam, How are most Jobs Found?, and Social Networks p. 18-19
 - Group 3: Read *Prepare for the Interview* and *Dress for Success* p. 29-30
 - Group 4: Read Practice Makes Perfect p. 30
 - Group 5: Read *The Interview* and *After the Interview* p. 30-32
- 4. Step 2: Form new groups so that each group has an "expert" from each area.
- 5. Step 3: Each student shares with their new group what they learned from their part of the reading.
- 6. Step 4: Discuss key points as a class. Encourage students to keep this as a resource to prepare for "Getting a Job".
