Reflection Paper Guide

What did you do and how is it relevant/meaningful to you?

Introduction:

Share a story, personal experience or quote related to your project. Be creative. The point is to grab the audience's attention.

Body of Paper – discuss:

- A. Why you chose your topic.
- B. The process of decisions you made and steps in doing the project.
- C. The importance of teamwork and your product, including those who helped you.
- D. The importance of communication in connection with your project
- E. Problems you encountered and ways you overcame or solved them
- F. What you learned from doing your project:
 - 1. about the topic,
 - 2. about yourself your time management, communication, organizational skills and abilities.
- G. What you would have done differently to improve your product or your experience
- H. Questions you might still have as a result of doing the project
- How your project connects to your future 1. Career direction, 2. Transferable
 skills

Conclusion:

Reflect on the EA project as a whole experience. End with a parting thought, or use a quote to describe your experience, or with a lasting image or a moment that will stay with you or that you will look back on when you think about your senior project.

Be sure to include as many details, examples and "anecdotes" (stories) as you can, to describe your experience. Your essay should be in MLA format and 2-4 pages.

<u>NOTE:</u> For use in your presentation you may convert your final paper into a PowerPoint that will lead you through your presentation.
