Objective:

The student will be able to identify local human services or charities to help meet the needs of specific scenarios.

Procedure:

1. Begin advisory according to personal preference.
2. Take attendance.
3. Read Announcements.
4. Pass out the "Poverty Assignment Sheet" and go over the directions.
5. Explain that students will use AG class time to complete the task.
6. Have students work in pairs – each pair will have one scenario.
7. Once students know the expectations they may begin working.
8. Please make sure students know that they will present their results to the class on March 16th or March 20th and that this is an academic lesson.
