

SHS Forecasting for 2018-2019

Day 2

Outcome: Familiarity with SHS curriculum guide, forecasting vocabulary, forecasting sheets, transcripts.

Materials: SHS Curriculum Guide, Forecasting Sheets, Transcripts

1. Explain to students that today they will be forecasting for their classes for the 2018-19 school year.
2. Distribute the SHS Curriculum Guides to AG students.
3. Give students time to explore their Curriculum Guide. Highlight the following areas:

School policies, procedures, diploma info, etc.:

- College credit
- NCAA or NAIA requirements
- Graduation requirements
- Types of diplomas
- 4-year university admissions requirements.

Note new courses available in the following departments:

- Science (i.e. AP Biology and AP Environmental Science)
- Social Studies (Protective Services program is expanding. Note: Protective Services courses were incorrectly listed in the curriculum guide under Social Studies; however, it is a CTE program.)
- Art (several courses are now offered for college credit)
- Mechanical Technology (Diesel Technology)
- Physical Education (Unified PE)
- Music (Music Theory)
- Computer Science has a whole new “pathway,” or set of courses. Here is a brief overview: *There are a growing number of jobs in the area of technology. The **Information and Communication Technology (ICT)** Program of Study here at Silverton High School offers technology fundamentals for a variety of positions in Information Technology (IT) and computer repair, Network and Information Systems (IS), Computer Science (CS) and Programming, Drafting and Engineering as well as Digital Media Communications (DMC). Courses are structured with a high degree of hands-on projects combined with self-directed learning. You will learn alongside staff who rely on your help in SFSD Tech and SCAN-TV. Come visit if you are interested!*

4. When students are ready, distribute the Forecasting Sheets and Transcripts. Transcripts should be used to guide students in the forecasting process. Please remind students of the following:
 - Choose classes carefully! You will be held to your requests.

- Complete the form in **PENCIL**.
 - Write neatly. Every line and box must be filled in. This includes electives and alternates sections.
5. Remind students of the following date:
- 3/14 completed forecasting sheets with **parent signatures** due to AG teacher
6. **During the next couple of days encourage students to visit teachers to get IA (Instructor Approval) signatures.**
