Materials: SHS Website – Students/AG/EA Project Overview/Class of 2019 EA Project

Procedure:

1. Begin advisory according to personal preference.
2. Take attendance.
3. Read Announcements.
4. **Objective:** Review the EA Project Information, Explore the Website, have students take the EA Project survey located on the website right below the EA Project options, and answer any student questions. Finally, encourage all of your students to explore and choose an option and begin moving forward before leaving for summer break.
5. Open up the Class of 2019 EA Project Website on the SHS Website – displayed/projected for all students to see. Take the time to explore the website with the students. Open up the various EA Project options. Locate the Survey that each student will take (note: the survey takes about 2 minutes). Scroll down and locate all the extra documents that students may or may not need depending on their project. All students will need a work log.
6. Ask all students to go ahead and take the **survey** after you have located it on the website for them.
7. Lead a discussion with your class. Which project are they leaning towards? What questions do they still have about the project? What information do they need in order to make a decision?
8. Encourage students to take the time now to find the information they need now and move towards making a decision. Remember, just because you decide on a specific project, doesn't mean you are locking yourself into a specific career. It's okay to do a project and they realize it's not for you.
9. Tell students that next Tuesday you will be exploring and working on actually choosing a project. The goal is to have all students make a decision before you leave for summer break and working on the project over the summer.
10. End advisory according to personal preference.
