Please take advantage of this opportunity to practice using various **Questioning and Discussion Techniques** (Danielson Framework 3b). Remember the critical attributes of a level 4 discussion are:
  - a. **Students initiate higher-order questions.**
  - b. **Teacher builds on and uses student responses to questions in order to deepen student understanding.**
  - c. **Students extend the discussion, enriching it.**
  - d. **Students invite comments from classmates and challenge one another's thinking.**
  - e. **Virtually all students are engaged in discussion.**
6. End AG according to personal preference.
