

The Justin Little Memorial Foundation History Award

The Justin Joseph little Memorial Foundation History Award will be given to one or more graduating high school seniors with an interest in American History who are planning to attend an Oregon Community College, and who will be enrolled in at least two history courses during the coming academic year. The requirements for this award are:

- Write an essay, not to exceed 500 words, on the importance of studying history, and describing your interest in American History including the Civil War; and (or as an alternative to the essay);
- Submit a letter of recommendation from a history teacher describing the applicant's genuine interest in history.

The essay and/or letter of recommendation will be reviewed by a scholarship committee and awards will be based upon the applicant's demonstrated interest, ideas, and effort.* This is not an academic contest or an award based upon financial need. It is rather an award to recognize sincere interest as a student of history.
