NOTE

Due to the pandemic, applicants for this scholarship should expect an online interview by the Silverton Lions Scholarship Committee.

Students we select will receive their Award (Lions Scholarship Recipient Award form-letter) at a Silverton High School AWARDS ceremony, or as the school may decide.

Each Lions Scholarship applicant who is awarded to receive a grant must complete and return their Lions Scholarship Recipient Award form-letter to the Lions Club, before January 1, 2023, so that the scholarship grant can be sent to the appropriate educational institution.

PURPOSE

The purpose of awarding Lions scholarship grants is to recognize and assist one or more public or private high-school student graduate(s) within the Silver Falls School District area who 1) are wholly or partially dependent on their own resources (unlimited by a specific income maximum) to finance their education; 2) exhibit significant contributions in school, career, and/or community services; and, 3) maintain a high level of academic performance.
